Do NOT take pills for diabetes on the g of your colonoscopy. STOP GLP-1 Agonists (Ozempic, Wegovy, Mounjaro, Trulicity, Victoza, us) seven (7) days prior to surgery.
	NE (1) DAY BEFORE SURGERY: Regular Food OR Clear Liquids Only IDNIGHT (12:00 AM), do NOT eat or drink anything. However, you may take medications with a ater.
